4. Copy of an admission letter to a post-secondary institution.

Interviews will be conducted in early-mid April 2024, and scholarships will be awarded shortly thereafter.

If selected, scholarship disbursement is dependent on student's proof of enrollment for the 2024-2025 academic year at a post-secondary institution.
